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DESCRIÇÃO GERAL DA DISCIPLINA:

Esse curso apresentará uma revisão dos estudos sobre línguas de sinais, explorando o desenvolvimento da aquisição em crianças surdas adquirindo uma língua de sinais e em crianças bilíngues bimodais, ouvintes, filhas de pais surdos, adquirindo uma língua de sinais e uma língua falada, simultaneamente. Os alunos vão estar participando das aulas e colocarão seus conhecimentos em prática utilizando o ELAN com anotações em áudio e vídeo para serem analisadas.

ORGANIZAÇÃO DO CURSO:

Os componentes do curso incluem aulas expositivas, discussão sobre as leituras, aulas práticas para análise de dados, um projeto em grupo.
